

Dress Code

For Employees and Volunteers

SERVE does not discriminate on the basis of dress. However, for the purposes of professionalism and safety a dress code will be enforced for staff and volunteers.

- Clothing may be casual except when otherwise indicated i.e. meetings, special events or other occasions.
- Clothing should be clean, and in good condition:
 - No excessive tearing, rips, fraying, or signs of wear.
- Clothing should not be excessively long or flowy to minimize the risk of it getting caught on equipment.
- Clothing may not display derogatory, violent, or offensive language, symbols, or marks.
- Body between upper arms and mid-thigh must be covered regardless of body position (sitting, standing, bending, etc.):
 - No tank tops or sleeveless shirts unless worn with a cover i.e. sweater or jacket;
 - Certain professional shirts and dresses may be permitted at the discretion of the Executive Director
 - Shorts and skirts should be no more than 3 inches above the knee;
 - Midriff and chest must be covered;
 - No exposed undergarments; and
 - No sheer or see-through clothing.
- Shoes worn in the warehouse/pantry areas must be closed toe and no heel;
 - This same restriction may apply at special events or other occasions.
- When representing SERVE at meetings, special events and other occasions clothing representing other businesses, organizations, causes, or activity outside of the scope of SERVE is not permitted.
